COLOUR RUN

COLOUR ORDER:

- Narelle Kriz says The Cobar Youth Council needs to order colour for the run and need to check for leftover bags of colour from 2015's colour run. There are two boxes of pink, blue and orange powder left to use this year's colour run;

- The Cobar Youth Council will order more colour from the Australian Rhino Promotions to

deliver to Cobar.

T-SHIRT DESIGN:

- Narelle Kriz suggests the Peaks of Colour t-shirts remain the same design as last year. The Cobar Youth Council may need to change the name of the event and t-shirt if the Peak Gold Mine chose not to sponsor the event. Peak are likely to be the major sponsor but they're not officially agreed on:
- Narelle Kriz will contact and invite Chris Higgins to talk to the Cobar Youth Council at the next meeting.

- The Cobar Youth Council brainstorm ideas to advertise the colour run. We will post frequent updates on the Cobar Youth Council Facebook page, advertise in the Cobar Weekly as well as papers in Bourke, Dubbo and Nyngan;
- Owen Potter wants to send a snippet about the event to radio stations such as ZOOFM and possibly make a television advertisement;
- The Cobar Youth Council will place posters around Cobar and take them to Nyngan and Bourke.
- The Cobar Youth Council cannot start promoting the event until they have sponsors on board.

OTHER:

- Travis Beckman has asked Narelle Kriz if the Cobar Youth Council would be involved in the Volleyball fun day. He suggests the Cobar Youth Council run the canteen at Ward Oval. The official date is to be announced but will likely be near the end of September.
